# National Association of Asian American Professionals-Seattle (NAAAP-Seattle) 2009 Scholarship

## Eligibility

- Asian Pacific Americans (APA) who will be **high school seniors during the 2009/2010 academic year** and who will be graduating from high school in the **Spring/Summer of 2010**
- Must be entering first year of college in the **Fall of 2010**
- Must have a 3.00 G.P.A. or higher (**submission of most recent official high school transcript is required**)

## Judging Criteria

All applicants will be judged on the following criteria:

- a. Academic achievement
- b. Leadership skills
- c. Community activities and involvement
- d. Scholastic activities and involvement
- e. Work or other activities
- f. Essay
  - Ability to clearly articulate ideas and answer essay question
  - Logical presentation of argument(s)
  - Grammar, spelling, and sentence structure

### Selection & Notification

- **Recipients will be selected and notified by the NAAAP-Seattle Scholarship Committee by Friday, October 16, 2009.**
- **First Place: \$3,000, Second Place: \$2,000**
- **Awards will be presented at the NAAAP-Seattle Gala on Saturday, October 24, 2009.**
- **Scholarship winners are required to be present and will be asked to give a brief acceptance speech at the Gala.**
